### From Your Pastor

It was the day of Preparation, and the Sabbath was beginning. The women who had come with him from Galilee followed, and they saw the tomb and how his body was laid. Then they returned and prepared spices and ointments. On the Sabbath they rested according to the commandment. —Luke 23:54-56

This is always the hardest part for a church.

For those who have not heard, it was announced on Sunday, April 21st, that I will be moving to Broadway United Methodist Church in Council Bluffs, Iowa this summer.

I am excited about the opportunities this new appointment provides, and I see the Holy Spirit at work in the coordination necessary to move me across conferences... again. While I did not ask for this move, and it is not the timing I would have chosen, I trust that God is at work in this, as in all things!

This is always the hardest part for a church.

This time of knowing that a pastor is leaving, before the anticipation of knowing who will take their place. This is liminal. This is anxious. This requires active faith and patient waiting.

After years of ministry, teaching and preaching the same stories of incarnation, miracles, death, and resurrection, I often find myself looking for the stories between the stories, the quiet moments between the showstoppers, and the things unsaid. Perhaps that's why the past few Easters I have found myself drawn to Holy Saturday.

We don't know what the day between "Good" Friday (I'm sure the disciples were not yet referring to it as such) and Easter Sunday looked like for Jesus' loved ones. Nothing is written about it. How they filled that time is left to the imagination.

What we do know is that they did not know that it would only last a single day. They did not know that tomorrow was Easter and that they would once again see the man whom they were grieving. For the disciples, Holy Saturday was just the first day of their new reality of life without Jesus. Thank God we are an Easter people!

Don't mistake me, we all have our Holy Saturdays, and they are not always (read: rarely) over in a single day. Yet, unlike the disciples, we know that death never has the last word, and God is never done with usl

I am not Jesus (you know this, but I need you to know that I know this!). My transition from Gretna is not the same as the death of a savior, or even a loved one or friend. And yet, it is good to remember during this time of active faith and patient waiting that God is still at work, and God's work for and with us is only just beginning!
